# Implementation Status and Key Decisions

Meghalaya Health Systems Strengthening Project (MHSSP) is scheduled to be implemented between 2022 and 2027. The project was signed on October 28, 2021 and declared effective on November 26, 2021. The Project Steering Committee (PSC) and the Project Executive Committee (PEC) and the State Project Management Unit (PMU) is in place. PMU has signed the contracts for the key consultancy services and also for the civil works that are critical to project. Technical discussion in all three components of the project has begun including designing of the Internal Performance Agreement (IPA).

To meet the timelines and to proceed ahead with technical design under each component, the project needs to complete the pending procurement and complete signing of contracts which are at ready to award stage.

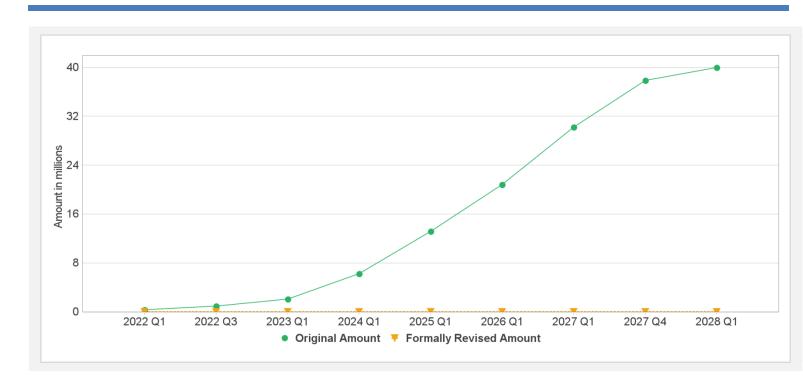
